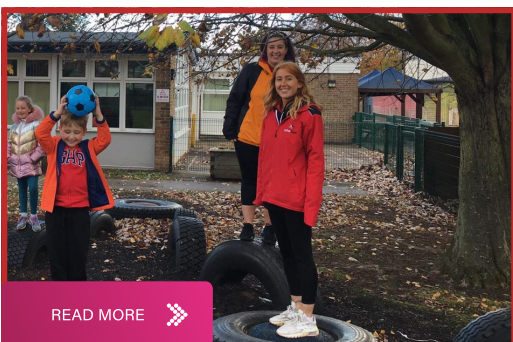
I WANT PEOPLE TO ACHIEVE AND TASTE SUCCESS. IT'S WHAT DRIVES ME EVERY DAY
