

How can your school fundraise for us?



Interested in supporting Active Fusion through fundraising? Explore these creative ideas to kick-start your efforts!

- 1. Triathlon Mini-Tri Event:** Organise a mini-triathlon event on the school grounds, featuring a scaled-down version of a triathlon. Students can participate in a short swim, a bike ride around the school track or designated area, and a run. Encourage students to gather sponsors for completing the mini-triathlon, with funds raised going towards the When You Tri 100K target.
- 2. "Tri for Charity" Sports Tournament:** Host a sports tournament among different classes or year groups, with teams competing in various sports like football, rounders, and relay races. This fosters friendly competition while raising funds for a good cause.
- 3. Crowdfunding Campaign:** Launch an online crowdfunding campaign through platforms like GoFundMe or Kickstarter. Share the campaign on social media and encourage parents, students, and the community to donate.
- 4. Triathlon Themed Bake-Off:** Hold a bake-off where students, teachers, and parents can showcase their baking skills by creating triathlon-themed treats. Set up booths to sell the baked goods during a school event, such as a sports day or open house. Encourage creativity and tie it into the school's fundraising efforts.
- 5. Sports-themed Festival:** Host a sports-themed carnival or festival with games, activities, and entertainment for children and families. Set up booths with carnival games like ring toss, bean bag toss, and mini golf, and offer prizes for winners. Charge a small fee for game tickets or wristbands for unlimited play. You can also include sports challenges and demonstrations.
- 6. Fitness Challenge:** Organise a fitness challenge where students pledge to complete a certain number of hours of physical activity over a set period, such as a week or a month. Participants can gather sponsors who pledge to donate a certain amount for each hour of activity completed.
- 7. Book Fair:** Organise a book fair in collaboration with a local bookstore or educational publisher. Offer a wide selection of books for students and families to purchase, and designate a portion of the sales as donations to the school.
